Classroom Procedure and Expectations J

- 1. We expect students to be on time in their assigned seats with their required choir materials before the tardy bell rings. If scholars arrive more than 1 minutes after the tardy bell without a pass, they must go to their attendance clerk. If they do not have a pass, they will not be allowed into the choir room. If they do have a pass they must knock and a director or student helper with let them into the choir room. Please be considerate of your fellow musicians by being punctual!
- 2. **Personal belongings** are not allowed on the risers (purses, fanny packs, phones, backpacks, etc.), unless otherwise instructed by the directors. Cubbies are provided for the storage of personal items and we expect students to take all their belongings with them each day when they leave the choir room.
- 3. WE ARE A NO CELL-PHONE CAMPUS & CHOIR ROOM! If a student uses a telecommunications device without authorization during the school day, the device will be confiscated. The student/parent may pick up the confiscated telecommunications device from Student Services for a fee of \$15. THIS IS THE NSHS PHONE POLICY AND DIRECTORS WILL ENFORCE IT TO ENSURE A SUCCESSFUL LEARNING ENVIRONMENT.
- 4. Choir is a hands-on, physical, and fast paced course. Student musicians are expected to be active, energetic listeners and participants in each rehearsal. Through daily skill demonstration and technique building our students will learn to become successful members of a choral ensemble. It is imperative that scholars take direction in a positive manner, have patience and learn to work with others. Also, our singers must come to class each day motivated to work hard and excited to make beautiful music.
- 5. **Food, gum, and beverages** are never allowed in the choir room without permission. Students may only bring closed containers of water into the room.
- 6. **Pianos and stereos** may not be played by students without permission. The pianos are expensive instruments, not pieces of furniture. Never place anything on a piano or use them for a writing surface.
- 7. **Practice rooms, library, uniform closet, and director offices** are off-limits without a director's permission and will remain locked unless permission is granted.

Music and Supplies J

- Choir Binder: (provided by Choir) Each student is assigned a choir binder, but it remains the property of NSHS Choir Department. It should be gently treated. Students must not deface the binder in any way. Mistreated or lost choir binders may be replaced for \$5.
- **Pencil Pouch:** (provided by Choir) Students will be issued a pencil pouch in their binder at the beginning of the year.

- **Pencils & Highlighter:** (provided by Choir) Students will be issued two pencils at the beginning of the year and must always have a pencil at their seat.
- Music: (provided by Choir) Students will be issued music and it is to be kept in their choir binder.

As a member of the choral program, you have an obligation to your fellow choir members to be at school, all outside-of-class rehearsals, and performances. You must be prepared, on time, and with the necessary materials at each required event.

Poor daily attendance is not tolerated or accepted.

- 1. All choir students must have excellent daily attendance.
- 2. Concerts and outside rehearsals: Attendance at sectionals, rehearsals, and concerts scheduled outside of the regular school day are required and graded. Absence from sectionals or outside-of-school day rehearsals will result in a reduction of grade, possible removal from performance opportunity or ensemble, and a make-up assignment.
- 3. Singers must call and email if an emergency causes an absence.

- 4. A Cappella members should call or email in advance if they will miss school for any reason, including field trips, "helping" other departments, etc.
- 5. Examples of **unexcused** absences include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Work
 - b. Oversleeping
 - c. Transportation
 - d. Driver's Ed (avoid March and April)
 - e. Babysitting siblings

J Grading Policy J

Grades in choir are determined in the following manner:

Formative grades (25%) including punctuality, having supplies, energy in the rehearsal process, dedication to excellence, and demeanor. Students will receive a weekly skill demonstration grade.

Summative grades (75%) are generally measured as mastery in performance on stated concert and after-school rehearsals, but may also take the form of tests, quizzes, sight-reading sing-offs, etc. Unexcused absences will result in a grade of 0% since concerts cannot be rescheduled in order for students to fulfill their music choral TEKS requirements.

Bear in mind that missed rehearsals and performances are lost opportunities and can never REALLY be made up in a meaningful way; however make-up work will be assigned for excused absences only. All other absences will result in a reduction of grade and possible removal from the ensemble or future choir enrollment.

Academic Eligibility J

Choir students are expected to maintain a passing class average in all courses. UIL Ensemble members no longer need to be eligible to participate. However, director discretion still applies; If a student is not working with diligence for UIL performances, they will be given an alternative assignment, and will not be allowed to participate. In order to support our students academically and hold them accountable we will have grade and Trojan P.R.I.D.E. checks every grading period. We want our students to be successful in and out of our choir room!

□ Consequences □

The Choral Department normally deals with very few discipline issues. The expectation for behavior and rehearsal discipline is high and in order to offer a safe learning environment we follow the Smith's discipline system, Clean Slate and abide by THE RULE that "No one has the right to Interfere with the learning, safety, or well-being of other or themselves. Consequences include, strikes per the clean slate system, student/teacher conferences, removal from rehearsal, alternative assignments, office referrals, removal from performance opportunities and/or field trips, and removal from the Choral Department.

□ Uniforms □

Choral uniforms require a large investment. The school district simply cannot afford to replace them often. Students are required to keep uniforms looking neat and smelling good. Please notify a Director in advance if you find any problems with your uniform throughout the year.

Do not wait until the day of a performance to let the Directors know of an issue.

SOPRANOS/ALTOS:

Choir will provide a black formal gown (\$75 replacement cost).

The student must provide low-heeled solid black close-toed shoes. Socks are unacceptable. No sandals, sling-backs, open-toed, or sneaker type shoes.

Appropriate jewelry: small earrings and rings

Inappropriate jewelry: necklaces, watches, or bracelets

Hair must be brushed and away from your face. Hair ornaments must be black and small.

TENORS/BASSES:

Choir will provide a black tuxedo jacket, black tuxedo pants, black cummerbund, and black band bow tie (\$150 total replacement cost).

Men must also provide solid black socks and solid black dress shoes. Any other color or lack of socks is unacceptable. No sneaker-type footwear is allowed, black or otherwise.

GENERAL UNIFORM INFO:

Parents/guardians are asked to carefully hem tuxedos and gowns (or have them professionally hemmed at a tailor shop), but may not make other alterations to the uniforms. Please do not cut the hem, or use tape, glue, staples, or iron-on stitches in order to hem the uniform. These methods damage the uniform and are unacceptable. Any loss or substantial damage to the uniform will result in a fine for the actual cost.

*ALL CHORAL UNIFORMS ARE SCHOOL PROPERTY. FAILING TO MAINTAIN OR RETURN YOUR UNIFORM WILL RESULTS IN BEING PUT ON THE DELIQUENT LIST

Choir Fee and Uniform Check-out Procedure I

The directors understand that beginning-of-school expenses can be stressful. In an ideal world, choral students would receive their binder, pencils, music, uniforms, bus expenses, entry fees, and scholarships for free! Sadly, the choral department doesn't have the resources to do so, but we keep our fees as low as possible to benefit **ALL** students.

- The Choir Activity Fee:
 - o \$75 Bel Canto, Cantori, Men's Choir (2nd, 5th, & 7th period choirs)
 - Includes: one uniform dry cleaning at the end of the school year, maintenance of the uniform (with the exception of hemming) music, busses throughout the year, UIL/Festival entry fee, choir t-shirt, back-to-school party and other socials throughout the year, snacks for after school rehearsals, lunch during UIL, clinicians, region and solo/ensemble entry fees, Holiday Caroling & Holiday Banquet ticket, and many other choral events throughout the year.
 - o \$100 A Cappella
 - Includes everything listed above, plus their Fall & Spring retreats, and one Spring Banquet ticket.
- **Uniform Fitting**: If any hemming or adjustments need to be made to your student's uniform, please ensure it is completed before the Fall Concert on October 17th.

<u>Uniform Fitting Day</u> Saturday, August 26th 9am-12pm

Students can sign up via Sign-up genius. An email with the link will be sent out by Parent Square and Remind. Students who are unable to be fitted during this time must make an appointment with the directors to get fitted during lunches or before/after school.

□ Fundraising □

The Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD has many financial responsibilities. Unfortunately, there is never enough money to provide every organization with all the monies needed to be successful. The Choral Department must assume responsibility for some expenses.

Fundraising efforts help purchase new music, fund voice lesson scholarships, provide guest clinicians for UIL Choir Contest, contribute to transportation costs, supplies, entry fees, and social activities and much more. This year's fundraising opportunities Include: Cookie Dough and Poinsettias In the fall semester then Popcorn fundraising in the spring semester.

Students will be provided with opportunities throughout the year to participate in fundraisers. Please help meet financial obligations by participating in at least one fundraiser.

Auditions and Placement

The Newman Smith choir program boasts seven performing choirs that participate in many of the same activities.

They are:

- **Bel Canto**: A beginning treble Choir class that focuses on basic vocal technique, musicality and sight-reading (music literacy). This choir often competes at UIL Contest. Open to 9th-12th grade students.
- Cantori: An intermediate treble Choir class that continues to expand the students' knowledge of vocal technique, musicality and sight-reading. This choir competes at UIL Choral Concert and Sight-reading Contest. Open to 9th-12th grade students.
- **Tenor & Bass Choir**: A beginning tenor/bass Choir class that focuses on basic vocal technique, musicality and sight-reading (music literacy). This choir competes at UIL Contest. Open to 9th-12th grade students.
- A Cappella: An advanced Choir class that is truly three-in- one. Varsity Treble, Varsity Tenor/Bass and Varsity Mixed make up this choir and meet in just one Choir period. These singers explore advanced choral literature and continue to sharpen their skills in vocal technique, musicality and sight-reading. It is often referred to as the AP class of Choir. The A Cappella choir competes at UIL and often other festival contests. Open to 10th-12th grade students.
- Troy Singers Vocal Ensemble: This show choir is taken in addition to A Cappella. Choreographed by guest choreographers, students in this class sing jazz, Broadway, big band, and pop music all while dancing. Open to 10th-12th grade students.

EACH choir member is offered an equal opportunity to excel and achieve. The success of the individual is of vital importance; therefore the placement of students in the appropriately paced class is a priority of the directors. The Directors are happy to visit with any student or parent regarding audition and placement requirements. The Choral Department website also contains further details. www.NSHSChoir.com

J Awards J

Students have many opportunities for individual recognition and awards in Choir. Here's a sample of individual awards student musicians could earn this year:

□ Letter Jackets □

Choir students may earn the NSHS Choir Letter/Letter Jacket by accumulating a certain amount of points as designated by the Directors. Students will receive a Letter Jacket Tally Sheet In class to keep track of the points they accumulate throughout the year. Students are responsible for keeping track of points and also for costs associated with personalizing the jacket.

□ Private Lessons □

Supplemental voice lessons are offered as enrichment to the classroom instruction. These lessons are designed to utilize the characteristic literature of the voice rather than rehearse the music a student will be performing in Choir. Participation in these supplemental lessons is optional, but highly encouraged.. Lessons last 25 minutes and may be scheduled during the Choir class, lunch, or after school. **NO LESSONS WILL BE SCHEDULED DURING A NON-MUSIC CLASS.** Voice lessons are available only to students enrolled in a Choir class. It is the responsibility of the student to notify his/her voice teacher at least 24 hours in advance if the lesson is to be canceled, unless a serious emergency arises.

Students will pay the private instructor directly. Cost of lesson is \$22.00 per lesson which is paid to the private teacher monthly. The Choral Department offers substantial scholarships to help offset the cost of lesson fees. Please see Mr. Lucero to discuss the requirements for scholarship consideration.
